Aidenvironment develops Realtime Deforestation Monitoring (RDM) reports to engage companies and urge action towards real-time deforestation events, as well as to support civil society and financial sector stakeholders in their efforts to halt deforestation linked to commodity production and trade. In Brazil, recent increase of deforestation rates is mostly linked to the expansion of Soy and Cattle production within Amazon and Cerrado biomes. The RDM report of August 2022 presents seven new cases linking recent deforestation to soy traders' and beef processors' supply chains. The seven new cases include the reporting of a total of 17,172 hectares of native vegetation clearance and 560 fire alerts in Amazon and Cerrado biomes. Among the reported clearance of native vegetation, around 6,850 hectares are in areas with 'extremely high' priority for biodiversity conservation, and around 9,600 hectares fall in Legal Reserves, mandatory preservation areas according to the Brazilian Forest Code. In addition, the report includes an 'ongoing' case, reporting a continuing deforestation in a case from the RDM 3 (June 2022), Fazenda Lucata (I and II) / Fazenda Gaúcha (I and II) in Juara (Mato Grosso).



Agropecuária Santa Barbara Xinguara (AgroSB) is the self-declared operator of this property, Lote 35 - Setor D (Fazenda Lyra) under alert in the rural environmental registry (CAR) (1). In the SIGEF cadastre system, the property is registered under Heitor Lyra (2). AgroSB, a company involved in cattle, soy, and corn production, is the second largest deforester in Brazil in the last 25 years based on Ibama's environmental fines database, with a BRL 83 million amount in fines in 2009, 2010, 2011 and 2017 (3). The company is the co-owner of six properties named Fazendas Lagoa do Triunfo I, II, III, IV, V, VI (1, 4), totaling 145,000 ha (5) - a conglomerate 20km north from the property under alert. There was continuous deforestation and fire in Lagoa do Triunfo farms in 2019 and 2020, next to significant alleged social and criminal behaviour of the company including slave labor and money laundering (6, 7, 8). In 2012, five workers were rescued from slave labour conditions in a farm controlled by AgroSB (9). AgroSB's cattle supply is directly and indirectly linked to the world's largest meatpackers JBS, Minerva, Frigol, Marfrig and Frigorífico Valêncio (10, 11).

João Jacintho Honório da Silva, Mara Ligia de Lacerda Chaves Jacintho and Mariozan Dantas dos Santos are being sued by Ibama since 2020 for the deforestation of 2,400 hectares of native vegetation at a linked farm, Fazenda Rosaura (São José do Xingu - MT) (1) According to the Environmental Agency of Mato Grosso state, Fazenda Araçatuba I has an authorization for deforestation and timber extraction in an area of 975 hectares between February 2022 and February 2027 (reference number 26229509) (2). The authorization covers the reported cleared area, but the satellite imagery checking found a total of 1,224 hectares cleared.



Antônio Bento Borges Neto and Lund Antônio Borges Júnior are the registered owners of LB Administração e Participações Ltda (CNPJ: 35.813.632/0001-59). Antônio Bento Borges Neto (also known as Toninho Lund) was city councilor in Carolina (MA) between 2016-2019 (1). Lund Antônio Borges, an alleged land grabber in the region known as Bico do Papagaio in North Tocantins, worth at least BRL 12.4 million (2). In 2005, Lund was on the Dirty List of slave labor (3). His farm Fazenda Santa Hilário in Araguatins (Tocantins) has been associated with violence against landless people multiple times (4). In August 2017, one landless worker was killed, but no one was prosecuted (4). He and his son Toninho Lund own several cattle farms in Maranhão and Tocantins. A linked company, Ytacayuna Agro Pecuária, (5) had its registration cancelled by Brazilian Agency for stock market regulation in 2012 (6), with a debt of over BRL 90 million with the federal bank Bando do Nordeste (7). Borges family is also linked to Frigotins, a slaughterhouse and metapacker in Araguaína (TO), that requested insolveny in 2018 (8). LB Empreendimentos, the other linked company, is registered as a "holding of non-financial institutions" (9), and its is linked to the company LB Leilões e Transportes, involved in animal transport (10).

This case concerns ongoing deforestation on the property Barra Velha (Correntina - BA). Between 1 March 2018 and 14 April 2019, a total of 1,660 ha of native vegetation were cleared on Fazenda Barra Velha, owned by Grupo Mizote. Grupo Mizote produces, trades, and expors soy, corn, and cotton. It is one of the main cotton producers in West of Bahia state (1). Paulo Massayoshi Mizote is (co-owner) of at least seven companies in Bahia: Barra Velha Agropecuária, Mizote Company, Associação dos Produtores da Gleba Nova América, FMP Algodoeira do Oeste, Agropecuária e Armazéns Mizote, ABAPA - Associação Baiana dos Produtores de Algodão, and Cooperativa de Desenvolvimento do Agronegócio do Oeste da Bahia. He was the 1st Secretary of the Bahia Cotton Producers Association (Abapa) between 019/2020 (2). In 2012, three members of the Mizote family -Paulo Massayoshi Mizote, Alysson Hideo Mizote and Eunice Matiko Ishida Mizote - were fined BRL 5.4 million for environmental infractions in Fazenda Sassapão, in Formosa do Rio Preto, having 2,262 ha embargoed by Ibama (3). Grupo Mizote is among the players in Correntina's water conflict and is listed in the Comissão Pastoral da Terra (CPT) report of agrarian conflicts over land, involving 240 families in 2016 and 2017 (4). In 2013, Correntina's citizens started a movement called "Fora Mizote" against a concession to deforest 24,600hectares of native vegetation requested by Grupo Mizote in the same Fazenda Barra Velha (5). In 2018, representatives of local communities impacted by Mizote's plans interposed a process in Bahia's Court of Justice (6). Paulo Massayoshi Mizote and his wife Eunice Matiko Ishida Mizote are also involved in a land dispute in Formosa do Rio Preto (BA) with alleged land grabber José Valter Dias, who is accused of forging documents and bribing local judges to confiscate an area of 300,000 ha (7). Grupo Mizote plans to implement cocoa plantations in Barreiras (Bahia). In 2014, MetLife, one of the largest global providers of insurance, annuities, and employee benefit programs, with 90 million customers in over 60 countries, provided a loan of USD 30 million to Paulo Massayoshi Mizote (8). Grupo Mizote collects the 11th largest volume of water in Cerrado biome in Bahia among the companies linked to the Bahia Association of Farmers and Irrigators (Aiba) and Abapa. The company has an authorization to capture 76.3 million litres per day from the Rio Grande Basin, one of the main tributaries of the São Francisco River (9).



Ricardo Faria bought the company InSolo in November 2021 becoming the 5th largest crop producer in Brazil with more than 120,000 hectares of crop cultivation, mainly soy (1). InSolo was the centre of the scandal involving Harvard University's endowment fund. The company was linked to a series of social and environmental impact in Piauí, reported by Chain Reaction Research (2), Grain (3), and Rede (4). Fazenda Ipê is also involved in a case of land grabbing (5). InSolo had soy trading links to Bunge and Cargill (6).

The considered property is a cluster of 4 farms all registered under STX Agropecuária (SIGEF 9011211143910, Fazenda gapucha Gleba A and B - Gleba Centro Oeste). The CAR declarations of the properties are already validated by SEMA (Environmental Agency of Mato Grosso state) and are part declared by STX Agropecuária (Fazenda Lucata I and II) and part by JCR Agropecuária (Fazenda Gaúcha I and II). The clearance reported falls in the part of the property's cluster declared in the validated CAR as Fazenda Gaúcha I (by JCR Agropecuária). The previous RDM report from June 2022 (1) included detected clearance of native vegetation in this same cluster of properties, falling in two farms: Fazenda Gaúcha I (JCR Agropecuária) and Fazenda Lucata I (STX Agropecuária). Both clearances are authorized by the environmental agency (54138116 & 32172616) (2). The properties have also approved Sustainable Forest Management plans for timber, however, one of these areas was embargoed for forest degradation in October 2021 (1,100 ha in Fazenda Gaúcha II). STX Agropecuária is active in the cattle and timber sectors and registered in different address including its headquarter in São José do Rio Preto (SP) (3). The owner of STX Agropecuária is linked to the ownership/management of other 43 different companies (4). STX Agropecuária is linked to at least 12 different cattle ranches in MT, most of them directly supplying slaughterhouses owned by JBS. In 2014, the owner of STX Agropecuária signed a Conduct Adjustment Term (translated from Termo de Ajustamento de Conduta - TAC) with the Environment Agency of Mato Grosso that defines the payment of BRL 5,000 per hectare for the compensation of the degradation of the Area for Permanent Conservation (APP) in Fazenda Boa Vista II, in Aripuanã (MT) (5). The company sign other TACs linked to degradation of native vegetation: in 2013 regarding Fazenda Jeedá, also in Aripuanã (MT) (6), and in 2011 regarding an unknown property in Vila Bela da Santíssima Trindade (MT) (7).

### **Methods & Sources**

Deforestation and fire alerts data are the starting point of the analysis for each of the case studies. After confirming the clearance of native vegetation through satellite imagery, each of the case is then analysed through the Aidenvironment database crossing data from different sources and datasets as described below. Finally, the data is validated by a local partner and a qualitative analysis of each case is developed making use of publicly available data.

#### **Deforestation & Fire**

We processed deforestation alert data from the INPE/Deter program for both biomes, Amazon and Cerrado. An alternative source is the Global Forest Watch (GLAD alerts) and the Mapbiomas Alertas platforms. The fire alerts are checked in the NASA/Firms platform and processed using EO Browser Copernicus Sentinel platform. For each selected case, the deforestation is confirmed through satellite images.

#### Landownership (SIGEF/SNCI/SNCR) and the Environmental Cadastre self-declaration (CAR)

The landownership data is from the Federal Tenure Land systems SIGEF and SNCI, crossing it with SNCR to identify the ownership. The landownership registration on local notary offices is not checked and might be different than the federal systems. The self-declaration for the Environmental Cadastre (CAR) is checked in the Federal System SICAR, including the Legal Reserves and Permanent Preservation Areas (APP) according to the Brazilian Forest Code. For some states, such as Mato Grosso and Pará, it is possible to check the CAR declarant name through the Environmental State Agencies' CAR platforms. It is important to highlight that CAR is not recognized as official ownership data.

#### **Brazilian Forest Code protected areas**

Legal Reserves and Permanent Preservation Areas (APP) are defined by the Brazilian Forest Code as having mandatory conservation status on private properties. The size of Legal Reserves in private properties varies according to the biome [80% Amazonia biome, 35% Cerrado biome inside Legal Amazon, 20% other areas], and Permanent Preservation Areas (APP) are those linked to water and soil conservation areas (close to river bases, wetlands, slopes, and high hills.) The Legal Reserve and APP areas considered in this report are those self-declared within the Cadastro Ambiental Rural (CAR) system – Brazil's environmental registration system. In some cases, the CAR was also used to find information on ownership because even if it is a self-declared document, in some cases it still provides the most recent information on who is operating in a property.

#### Conservation areas and Indigenous Territories

Conservation Areas data is from the ICMBio, responsible for monitoring and management the Officially recognized Natural Reserves according to the National System of Natural Reserves (SNUC – Sistema Nacional de Unidades de Conservação). The SNUC determines jurisdiction of the area - federal, state or local government, or private owner - and how the natural resources may be used by whom in each of the natural reserves' categories. Indigenous Territories data is from FUNAI, the National Foundation for Indigenous Populations. Indigenous Territories are officially recognized and determine areas where local Indigenous populations have customary rights to access and use the land.

#### Type of Vegetation and Priority for Biodiversity Conservation

The type of vegetation data is from the IBGE (Brazilian Institute of Geography and Statistics) and Embrapa, consulted through the INPE website. The classification according the Priority for Biodiversity Conservation is from a study elaborated by the Brazilian Ministry of the Environment updated in 2018.

### **Methods & Sources**

#### **Environmental Embargoes and Fines**

Embargoed areas and Environmental fines are checked in the database form IBAMA, the Federal Environment Agency. Embargoes are areas where any kind of activity is suspended or unauthorized by IBAMA oftentimes due to environmental degradation or other crimes such as slavery labor. Properties can be removed from the list of embargoed areas after having addressed the problem. Environmental fines are usually linked to regulation infractions and are addressed to the owner of the property.

#### Company Group and linked properties

Once the ownership of the property is clearly linked to an individual, we use the SINTEGRA database to check all the registered companies under this individual or group of individuals names. If the ownership is already registered by a company, we also check the corporate structure of the company through open sources websites. Once the ownership, linked companies and corporate structure are defined, we search for other properties registered under the same or similar ownership in the Federal Tenure Land systems SIGEF and SNCI.

#### Level of certainty of links to soy traders and beef processors

**Soy** – <u>High</u>: trading relationship between the owner of the property and the trader is confirmed by traders or by the National Supply Company (Conab) trading subsidy programs, or traders have assets (warehouses) within the boundaries of the property; <u>Medium</u>: trading relationship with the corporate group, not necessary with the specified property is confirmed by traders or by Conab's subsidy programs; <u>Low</u>: trader is the main soy exporter in the municipality (Trase platform), or traders have assets (warehouses) within a radius of 50 km from the property.

**Cattle** - <u>High</u>: animal transportation data (GTA) confirm direct trading relationship between the property and beef processors; <u>Medium</u>: animal transportation data (GTA) confirm indirect trading relationship between the property and beef processors; <u>Low</u>: beef processor is the main meat exporter in the municipality (Trase platform), or beef processors have assets (slaughterhouse) within a radius of 50 km from the property.

#### Main exporters (municipality), warehouses and slaughterhouses

The data on main soy and beef exporters per municipality is from Trase platform. Warehouses' location is from the SICARM, and slaughterhouses' location are from the Ministry of Agriculture. The municipalities' export data and companies' assets location are only an indication of a potential trading link, not being used as prove of trading links as explained in the previous item (level of certainty of links to soy traders and beef processors).
