Soy Supply Chain in Cerrado biome - Brazil





Aidenvironment develops **Realtime Deforestation Monitoring (RDM)** reports to engage companies in urging action and support civil society and financial sector stakeholders in their efforts to halt deforestation linked to commodity production and trade. In Brazil, deforestation rates are mainly linked to the expansion of Soy and Cattle production within the Amazon, Pantanal and Cerrado biomes.

The RDM 21 report of June 2024 highlights 9 case studies linked to the soy supply chain in the Cerrado biome. The cases include the indication of non-compliance with the **European Union**Deforestation Regulation (EUDR) covering deforestation of native vegetation classified as Forest type, according to the forest definition of FAO, happening after December 2020. The 9 cases present 9,217 hectares of deforestation in Maranhão, Tocantins, Piauí and Bahia states (or Matopiba region of the Cerrado biome), of which at least 3,359 hectares are non-compliant with the vegetation type criteria of the EUDR. The cases cover deforestation alerts detected during May 2024, with visually confirmed deforestation events happening between December 2023 and June 2024.

Together with the confirmed cleared area of native vegetation, the RDM also estimates the linked CO₂ emissions (above-ground carbon emissions) according to vegetation type. The 9 cases of the RDM 21 report represent a gross emission of up to 0.7 million tons of CO₂.

In February 2024, Roberta Brennad Souza Leão received authorization for the clearance of 3,238 hectares of native vegetation at Fazenda São João (1). Between 2020 and 2022, two other properties of the Brennand Souza Leão family (Fazenda São Pedro e Fazenda Borda da Mata) also received authorizations for the clearance of 4,700 hectares of native vegetation (2, 3). One of the family members, Roberto de Souza Leão Filho, was prosecuted for the assassination of the farmer Brasilino Dias Ramos, linked to the dispute of ownership of Fazenda Natália (4). The father of Roberto was the main financier in the state of Pernambuco of the "Comando de Caça aos Comunistas" (CCC), a paramilitary organization that kidnapped political dissidents during the military dictatorship in Brazil. Roberto de Souza Leão was pointed out by the Truth Commission as the man behind the assassination of the catholic priest Padre Henrique (5). Brennand Souza Leão family is still active in politics in Pernambuco state. A linked case, Fazenda Borda da Mata (São Desidério - BA), was part of the Rapid Response Report 14 (June 2020) and a Realtime Deforestation Report (RDM 12), published in May 2023. Bunge, Cargill, and Cofco claimed no trading links with this linked property (6).



In March 2022, José Ademir Toniazzo received authorization for the clearance of 472 hectares of native vegetation at Fazenda Rancho Alegre, which is valid until March 2024 (1). Anderson Toniazzi, a relative of José Ademir Toniazzo, is one of the directors of the APRUP, Association of Rural Producers of Pratudão River, which is active in the agribusiness sector of West Bahia (2). Other Toniazzo family members are also part of AIBA, the Association of Irrigation in Bahia (3), and ABAPA, the Association of Cotton Producers (4). In July 2023, José Ademir Toniazzo and other members of the Toniazzo family benefited from a court decision that gave them the land rights of more than 400,000 hectares, an area previously occupied by 342 small farmers in Correntina, in Bahia (5, 6).

General comments

Ferdinando Valle Magalhães, one of the owners of Asa Agrícola, Agronol, and GSI Agronegócios, deceased in September 2023. In 2008, he received a Prize for his entrepreneurship capacity in an event organized by the National Society of Agriculture (SNA) (1). Márcia Magalhães Deccache, also linked to the same companies, is one of the founders of the political party "Novo" (2). The Deccache family is cited in land-grabbing cases in south Bahia, being involved in bribing Indigenous leaders from Pataxó people to convince their communities to stop pressuring for the official recognition of their territory (3). The region of Ponta de Corumbau, in Pardo (BA), has been under pressure from the hospitality industry for the development of resorts (4). The partners of companies that operate in the hotel business (Grupo Santa Isabel and Protell) are also partners of Agronol and Asa Agrícola (5). In April 2021, Asa Agrícola Santo Antônio S.A. received authorization for the clearance of 1,345 hectares at Fazendas Santo Antônio I, II, III, IV, V and VI, valid until April 2024 (6). The company also obtained authorization for the clearance of 1,176 hectares at Fazenda São Joaquim and São Luiz valid until April 2023 (7).



Other supply chain links and details: -

The Samara Agronegócios Group is mentioned as the owner of one of the highest soy-productivity properties in Maranhão in 2022 in an advertisement of a soybean variety commercialised by Bayer (1). In 2018, the company JJ Agronegócios, linked to Samara Group, was one of the soy traders that received environmental fines from the Federal Environmental Agency (IBAMA) for purchasing soy produced in an embargoed area in Balsas (MA). The company JJ Agronegócios received a fine of BRL 110,000, Cargill of BRL 5 million, and Bunge of BRL 1,87 million, among the fines received by other companies (2). In March 2023, Jamil João Samara was fined by the Maranhão Environment Secretariat for carrying out aerial spraying without registration, not having a decontamination yard and storing product packaging inappropriately on the linked property Fazenda Cacimbas (3). In 2021, the deforestation of an area at Fazenda Cacimbas resulted in impacts on three communities in São Domingos do Azeitão, affecting 30 families who had their subsistence production affected by mud. The families filed a lawsuit against Jamil João Samara, who was ordered to recover the deforested area (4).

General comments

Agropecuária Marimbondo, one of the companies through which Euclides de Carli operated, sold the property Fazenda Marimbondo in Alto Paranaíba (MA) to Tellus Agropecuária (1), one of the subsidiaries of Radar, linked to the TIAA (2). Fazenda Marimbondo, the south part of the property under alert, is part of TIAA's farmland portfolio, and it is linked to the TCGA II investment fund (3). On the Nuveen website, the TIAA's farmland investment manager, the property Fazenda Marimbondo appears as "leased", but there is no information about who is operating it (3). The TCGA farmland investment vehicles include in its portfolio of investors global pension fund companies such as AP2 (Sweeden), BCI (Canadá), and ABP (Netherlands), among others (2). The estimated land portfolio linked to TIAA (through Radar and other subsidiaries) is about 15 properties in Maranhão, Piauí and Bahia states, totalling at least 95 thousand hectares, among which at least nine properties (around 28 thousand hectares) are leased to SLC Agrícola (2). The north part of the property under alert, Fazenda Engano, where the reported deforestation is, does not appear in TIAA's farmland portfolio. We also could not find any information about selling operations involving Fazenda Engano. However, the local Agrarian Court estimates that 300,000 ha of land in Maranhão and Piauí states are linked to De Carli's land-grabbing crimes and also accused of violence and threats connected to invasions of lands occupied by local communities (4, 5, 6, 7).





Ademar Diógenes Lustosa is an entrepreneur from Bom Jesus (PI) (1). In 1998, Lustosa bought Fazenda Quilombo from Ademar Queiroz Diógenes and Maria do Carmo Pequeno Diógenes, both already deceased (2). An Environmental Impact Study from February 2022 indicates that Fazenda Quilombo is managed by the company Fazenda QBO Empreendimentos e Participações, owned by Sequoia Empreendimentos e Participações, Fábio Greco, and Amaury Fonseca Junior (3). The company requested authorization for the clearance of 3,050 hectares of native vegetation at Fazenda Quilombo to implement grain cultivation (4), which was issued by the Environmental Agency of Piauí in July 2023 and is valid until July 2027 (5).

Methods & Sources

Deforestation and fire alert data are the starting point of the analysis for each case study. After confirming the clearance of native vegetation through satellite imagery, each of the cases is analyzed through the Aidenvironment database crossing data from different sources and datasets as described below. Finally, the data is validated by a local partner, and a qualitative analysis of each case is developed using publicly available data.

Deforestation & Fire

We processed deforestation alert data from the INPE/Deter program for both biomes, Amazon and Cerrado. The Global Forest Watch (GLAD alerts) and the Mapbiomas Alertas platforms are alternative sources. The fire alerts are checked in the NASA/Firms platform and processed using the EO Browser Copernicus Sentinel platform. For each selected case, the deforestation is confirmed through satellite images.

Landownership (SIGEF/SNCI/SNCR) and the Environmental Cadastre self-declaration (CAR)

The landownership data is from the Federal Tenure Land systems SIGEF and SNCI, crossing it with SNCR to identify the owner. The land ownership registration on local notary offices is not checked and might differ from the federal systems. The self-declaration for the Environmental Cadastre (CAR) is checked in the Federal System SICAR, including the Legal Reserves and Permanent Preservation Areas (APP), according to the Brazilian Forest Code. For some states, such as Mato Grosso and Pará, it is possible to check the CAR declarant name through the Environmental State Agencies' CAR platforms. It is essential to highlight that CAR is not recognized as official ownership data.

Brazilian Forest Code protected areas

The Brazilian Forest Code defines Legal Reserves and Permanent Preservation Areas (APP) as having mandatory conservation status on private properties. The size of Legal Reserves in private properties varies according to the biome [80% Amazonia biome, 35% Cerrado biome inside Legal Amazon, and 20% other areas]. Permanent Preservation Areas (APP) are those linked to water and soil conservation areas (close to river bases, wetlands, slopes, and high hills.) The Legal Reserve and APP areas considered in this report are those self-declared within the Cadastro Ambiental Rural (CAR) system – Brazil's environmental registration system. In some cases, the CAR was also used to find information on ownership because even if it is a self-declared document, in some cases, it still provides the most recent information on who is operating in a property.

Conservation Areas and Indigenous Territories

Conservation Areas data is from the ICMBio, responsible for monitoring and managing the Officially recognized Natural Reserves according to the National System of Natural Reserves (SNUC – Sistema Nacional de Unidades de Conservação). The SNUC determines the jurisdiction of the area - federal, state, or local government or private owner – and how the natural resources may be used by whom in each of the natural reserves' categories. Indigenous Territories data is from FUNAI, the National Foundation for Indigenous Populations. Indigenous Territories are officially recognized and determine areas where local Indigenous populations have customary rights to access and use the land.

Type of Vegetation and Priority for Biodiversity Conservation

The type of vegetation data is from the IBGE (Brazilian Institute of Geography and Statistics) and Embrapa, consulted through the INPE website. The classification according to the Priority for Biodiversity Conservation is from a study elaborated by the Brazilian Ministry of the Environment, updated in 2018.

Methods & Sources

Environmental Embargoes and Fines

Embargoed areas and Environmental fines are checked in the database from IBAMA, the Federal Environment Agency. Embargoes are areas where any activity is suspended or unauthorized by IBAMA, oftentimes due to environmental degradation or other crimes such as slavery labor. Properties can be removed from the list of embargoed areas after addressing the problem. Environmental fines are usually linked to regulation infractions and are addressed to the property owner.

Company Group and linked properties

Once the ownership of the property is linked to an individual, we use the SINTEGRA database to check all the registered companies under this individual or group of individuals' names. If a company already registers the ownership, we also check the corporate structure of the company through open-source websites. Once the ownership, linked companies, and corporate structure are defined, we search for other properties registered under the same or similar ownership in the Federal Tenure Land systems SIGEF and SNCI.

Level of certainty of links to soy traders and beef processors

Soy – <u>High</u>: the trading relationship between the owner of the property and the trader is confirmed by traders or by the National Supply Company (Conab) trading subsidy programs, or traders have assets (warehouses) within the boundaries of the property; <u>Medium</u>: trading relationship with the corporate group, not necessary with the specified property is confirmed by traders or by Conab's subsidy programs; <u>Low</u>: the trader is the leading soy exporter in the municipality (Trase platform), or traders have assets (warehouses) within a radius of 50 km from the property.

Cattle – <u>High</u>: animal transportation data (GTA) confirm the direct trading relationship between the property and beef processors; <u>Medium</u>: animal transportation data (GTA) confirm the indirect trading relationship between the property and beef processors; <u>Low</u>: the beef processor is the leading meat exporter in the municipality (Trase platform), or beef processors have assets (slaughterhouse) within a radius of 50 km from the property.

Leading exporters (municipality), warehouses, and slaughterhouses

The data on main soy and beef exporters per municipality is from the Trase platform. The warehouses' location is from the SICARM, and the slaughterhouses' location is from the Ministry of Agriculture. The municipalities' export data and companies' assets' location only indicate a potential trading link, not being used as proof of trading links as explained in the previous item (level of certainty of links to soy traders and beef processors).

CO₂ Emissions

The calculation of CO_2 emissions refers to the "above-ground carbon emissions" according to the cleared vegetation type(s) [Source: 1) Nogueira et al. (2015). Carbon stock loss from deforestation through 2013 in Brazilian Amazonia], 2) United Nations Framework Convention on Climate Change (2016). Brazil's Forest Reference Emission Level for Reducing Emissions from Deforestation in the Cerrado biome for Results-based Payments for REDD+ under the United Nations Framework Convention on Climate Change. The tons of CO_2 emission is calculated per type of vegetation times the ratio of molecular weight of carbon dioxide to carbon (44/12) times the number of hectares cleared.
