



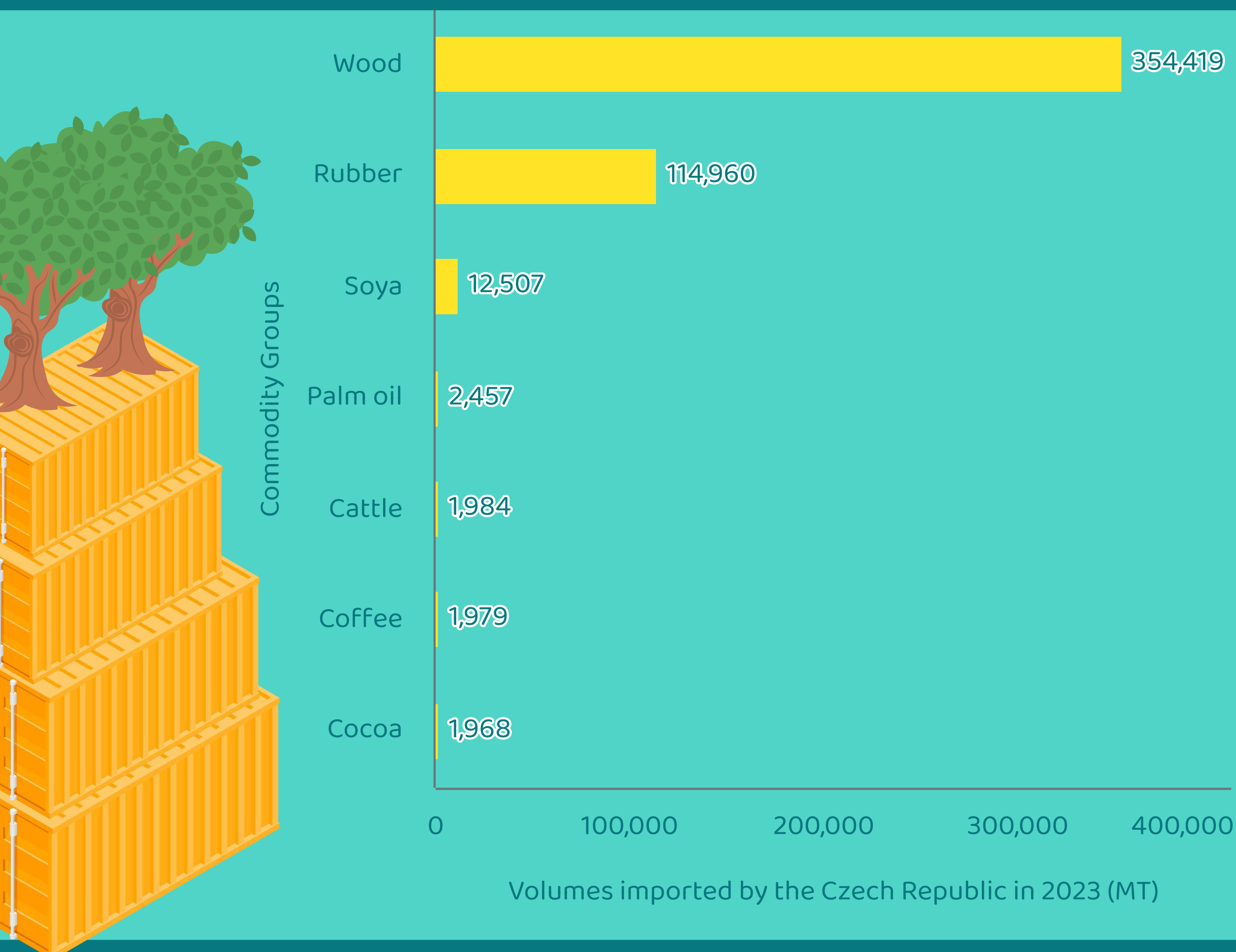

Czech Republic's largest contribution to total EU imports from non-EU countries in 2023 was made in rubber products.

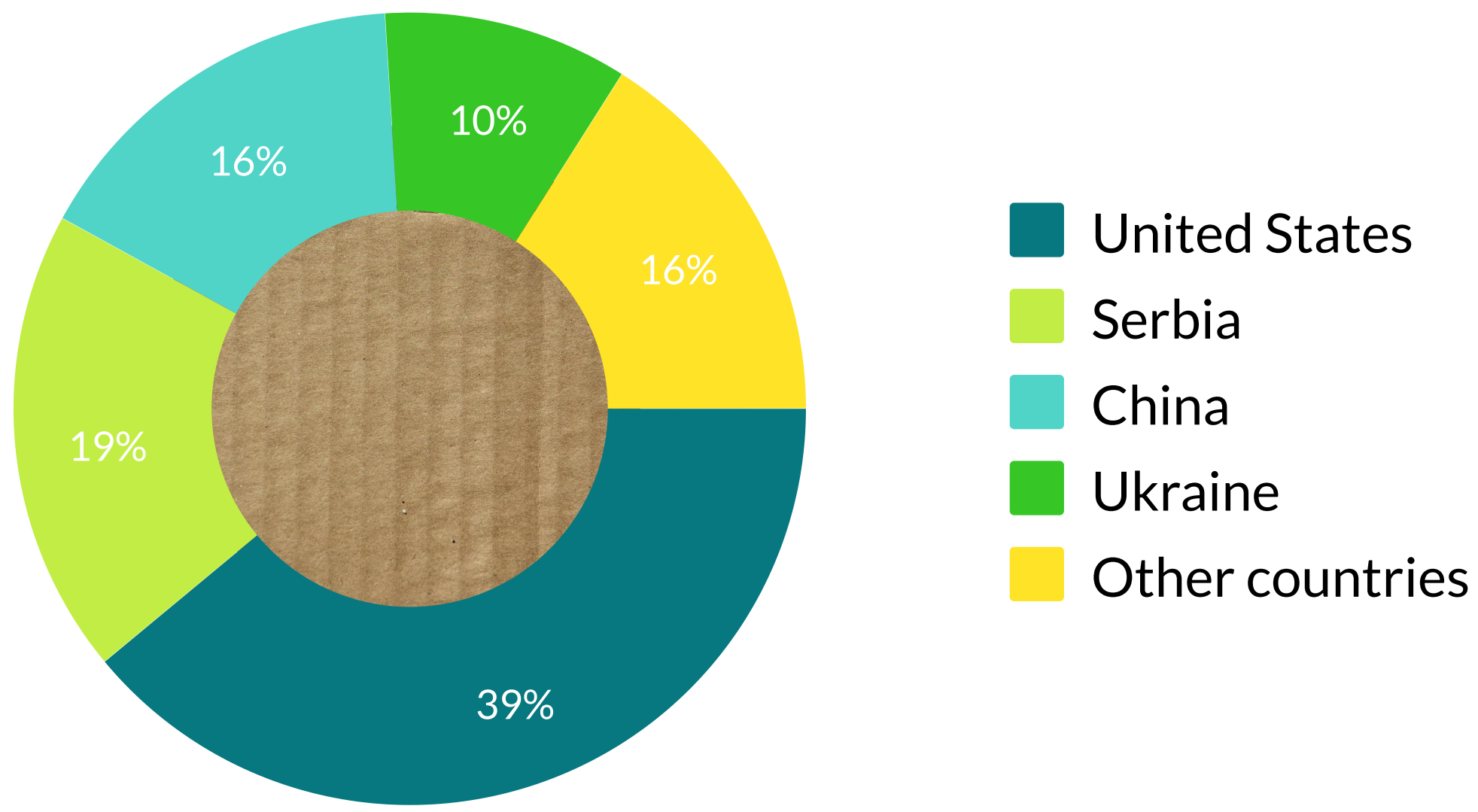

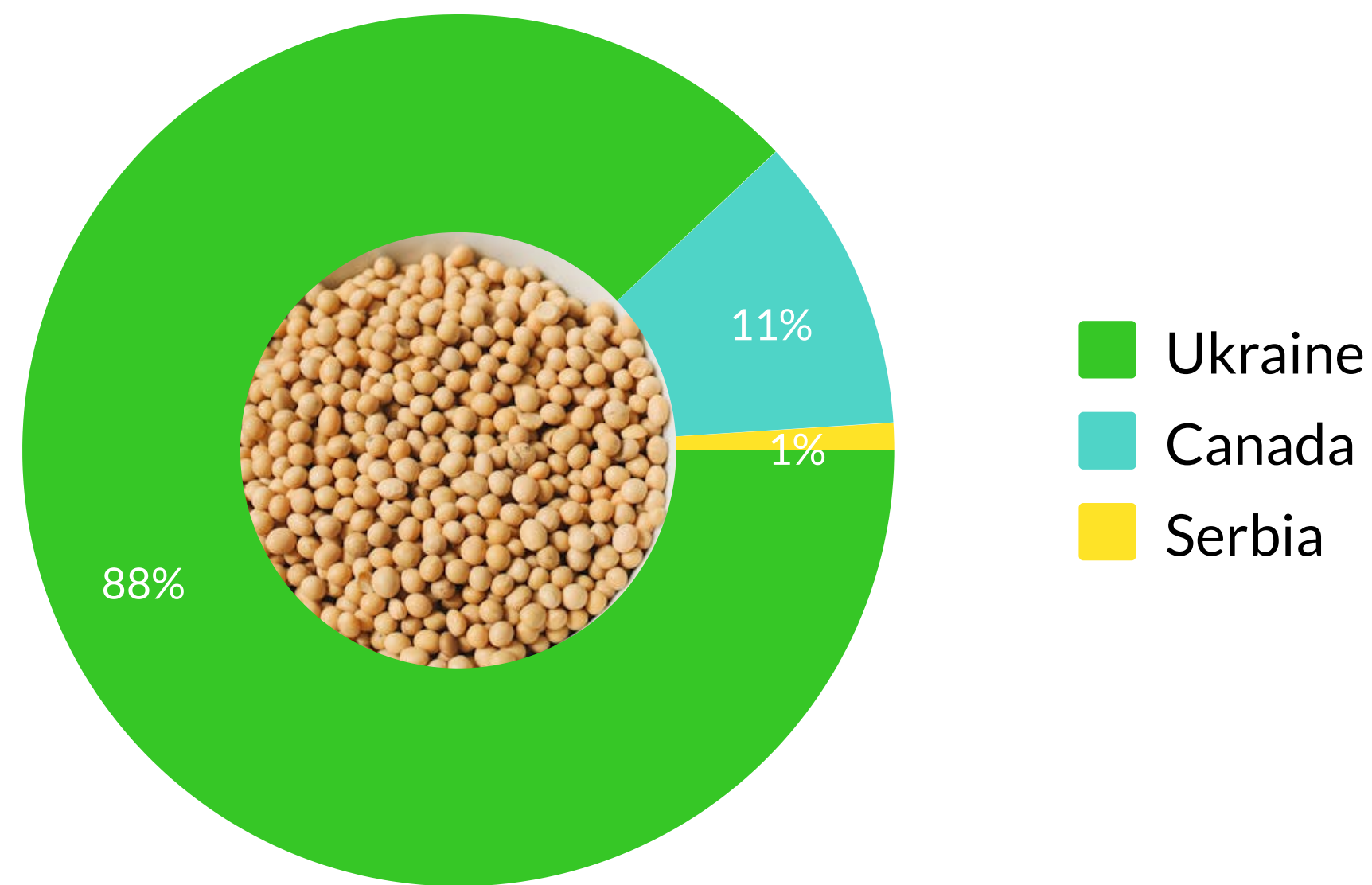

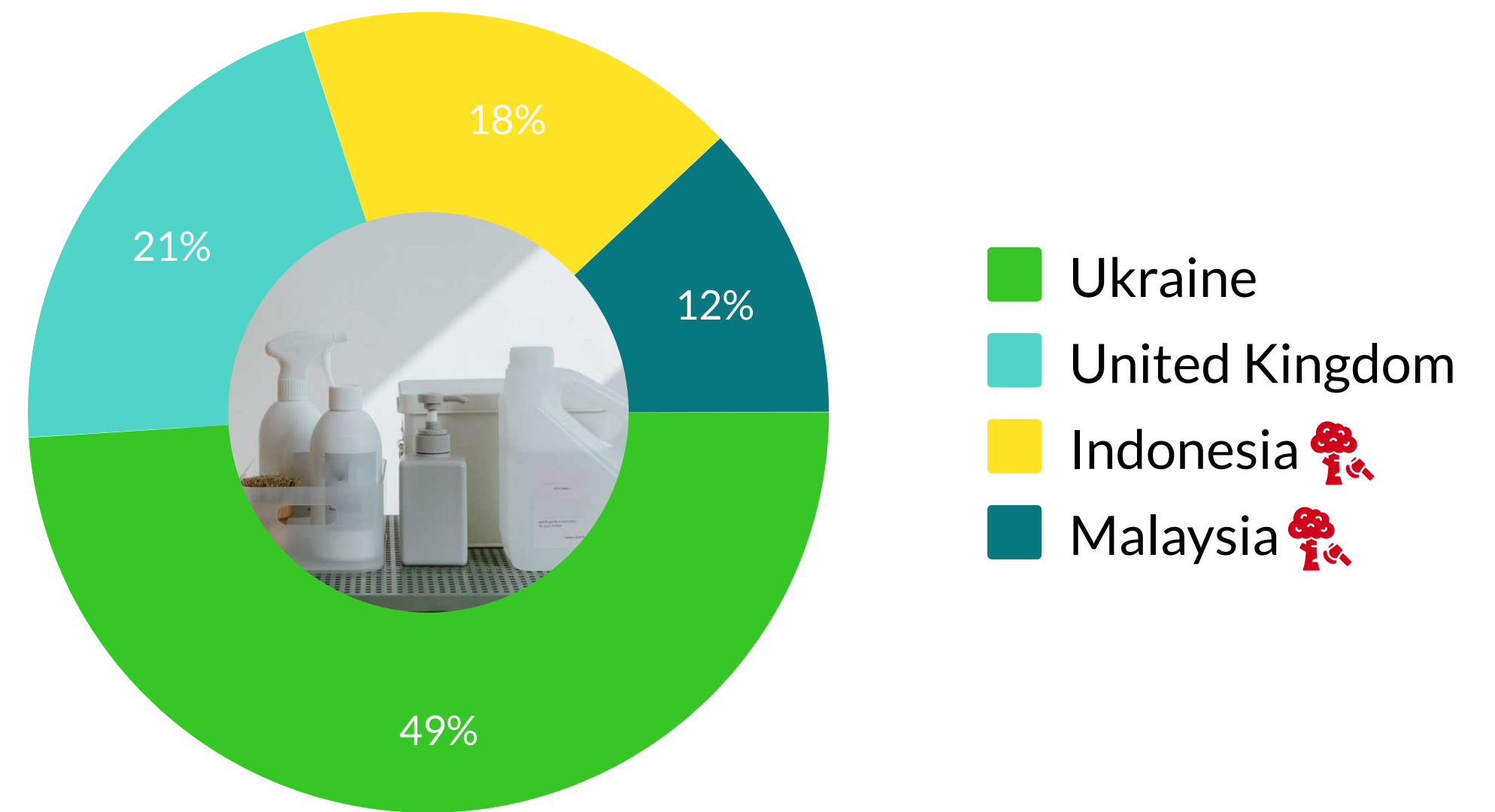

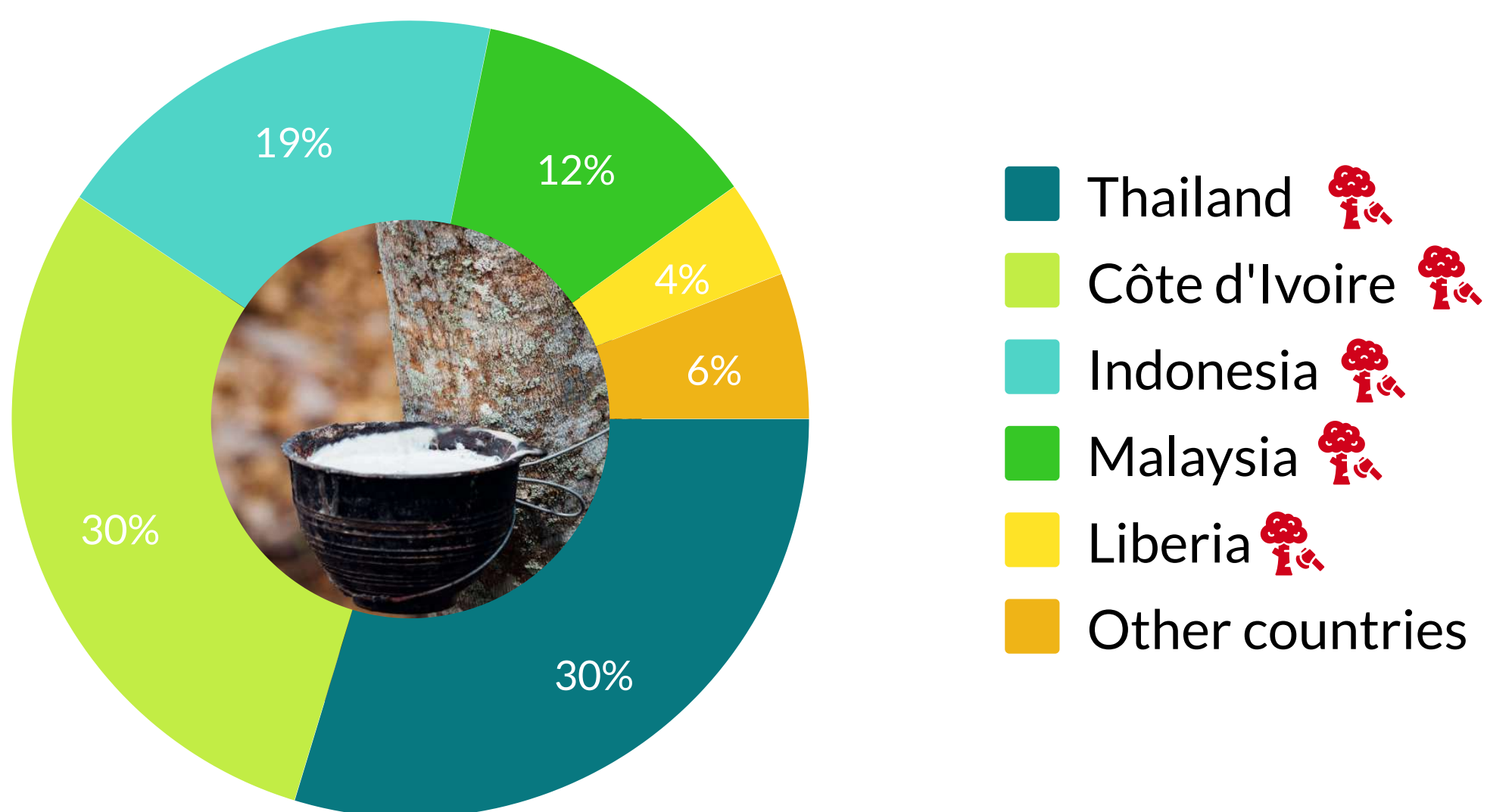
HS 1201- Soybeans



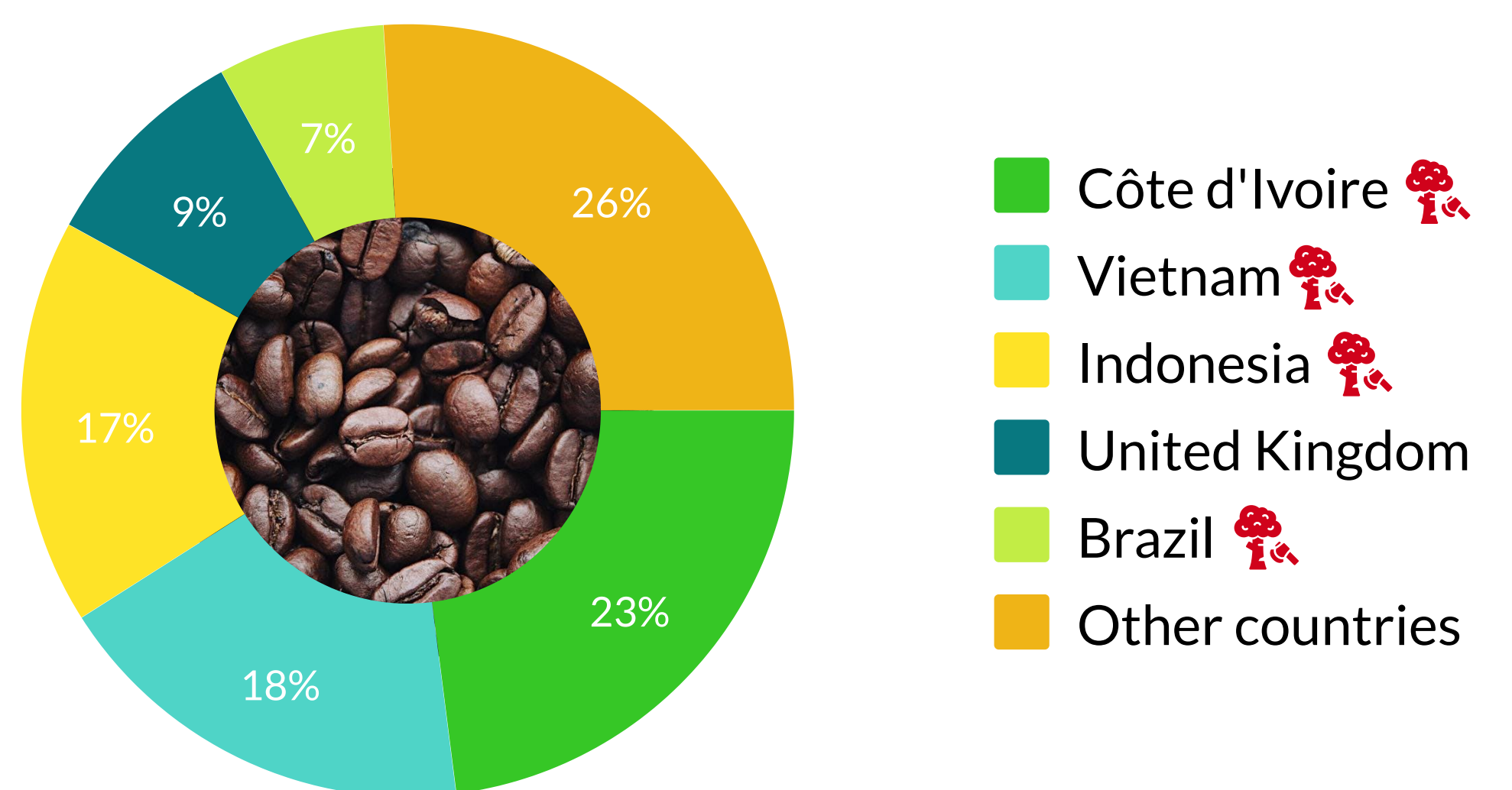
HS 382319- Fatty acids, industrial, monocarboxylic



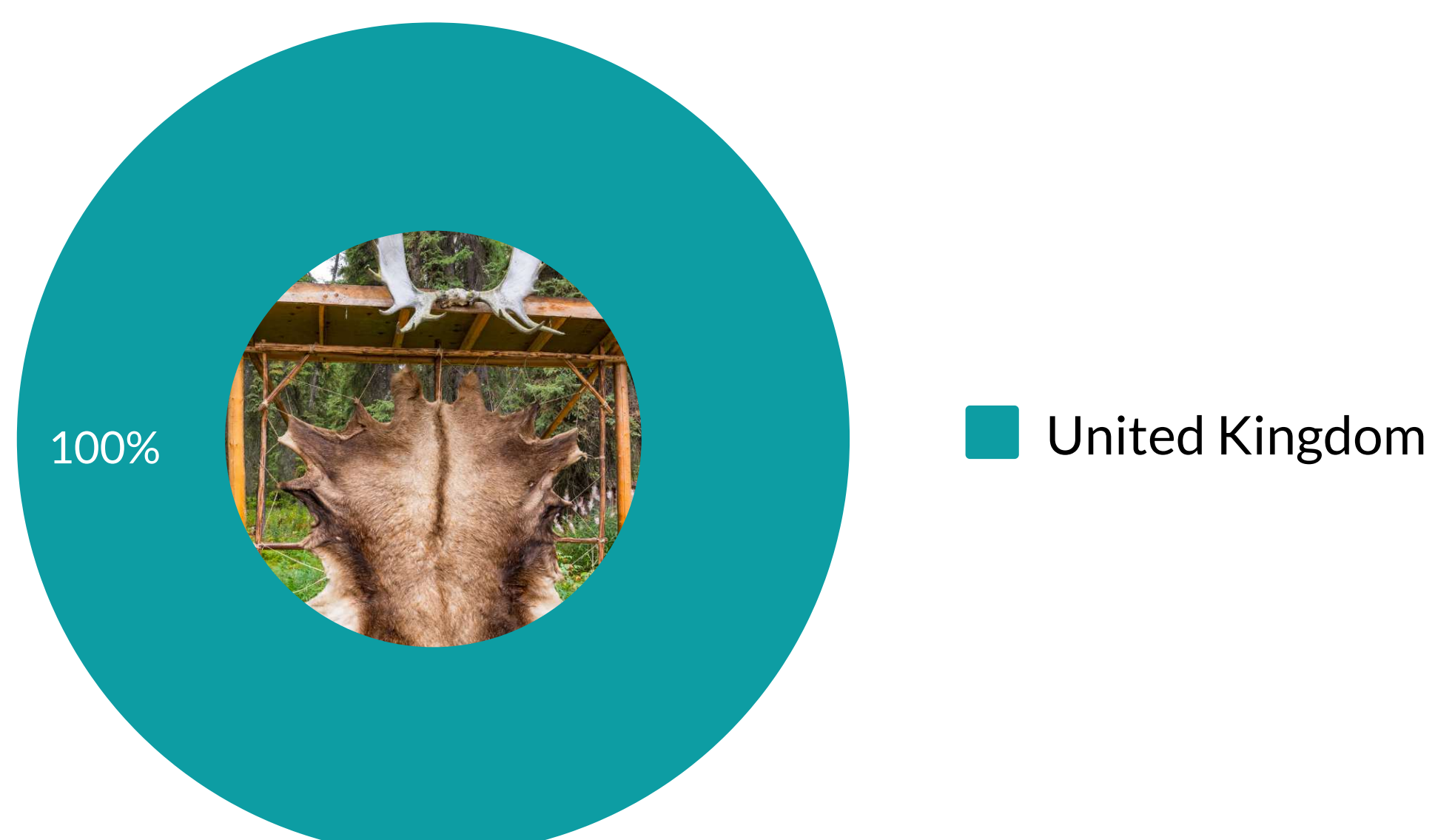
HS 4001 - Natural Rubber
